

NSUSSC, shared the Eid Happiness with underprivileged families



North South University Social Service Club (NSUSSC) has shared the happiness of Eid with the underprivileged families. This time they were on the field with their newest event 'Sponsoring an Eid-2014'. The basic function of the event was collecting money from the students, faculty members and clubs in North South University in form of donation to buy traditional Eid meals.

In our country several families cannot afford to celebrate Eid in the traditional way, so NSUSSC had targeted around 150 families this year, dwelling in the slum of Kuril, Bashundhara, to provide traditional Eid meal package. The package was designed in such a way to prepare Eid foods for a family consisting of 5-6 members. Each pack contained: 1kg Pulao Rice, 1kg Shemai, 0.5ltr Soybean Oil, 1kg Sugar, 100gms Powder Milk, Garam Masala, Kismis and Spices which is worth of BDT 520/- (Five hundred and twenty taka). To sponsor a family one is expected to donate BDT 520/- individually or he/she can make up a group and donate the money or they can buy the package themselves and give it to NSUSSC for donation. The students were seen ever eager and enthusiastic to be a part of this noble cause.

Students expressed their thoughts by saying, "We haven't lived today until we have done something for someone who can never repay us." And the "Sponsoring an Eid-2014" is a small initiative taken by the social worriers of North South University to share the happiness of Eid.
