

Carleton College students attended an off-campus study program at NSU

On Sunday, 7th December 2014, a team of 13 international students from Carleton College, Minnesota, USA visited North South University in an off-campus study program, accompanied by Dr. Faress Bhuiyan instructor of the Department of Economics at Carleton College.
