

Training on Scientific Writing

About the Program

NSU Global Health Institute and **NSU Library** are jointly offering a training program on **Scientific Writing**. The aim of the program is to enhance the capability of participants to write good scientific papers. The program emphasizes the quality of writing and dissemination with a view to improving readability, maximizing the contribution of the research done and improving the opportunities for publishing. The program is highly participatory and takes the practical and applied approach to learning.

Who Should Apply?

The learning package can be applied to a range of disciplinary and research settings. The program will benefit a diverse range of learners including early-career researchers, mid-level colleagues, research librarians, Ph.D., Masters and Undergraduate research students.

Program Outcome

- Describe the scientific writing process and its key stages.
- Reflect on what constitutes a research problem to be addressed in a scientific paper.
- Organize and compose a scientific paper in accordance with the standard model.
- Analyze and review scientific papers in terms of key message, consistency, and justification.
- Competency on using research tools (e.g., Scopus, Mendeley, EndNote, Turnitin, Grammarly, etc.)
- Reflect on the ethics in scientific writing.

Teaching & Learning Methods

The program will encompass specific facilitator inputs (e.g., lecture presentations), combined with a variety of interactive learning activities, including:

- Structured group work
- Group and individual reflection
- Self-study and writing
- Presentation
