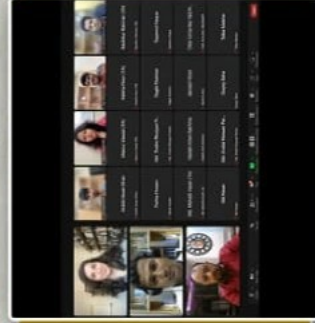

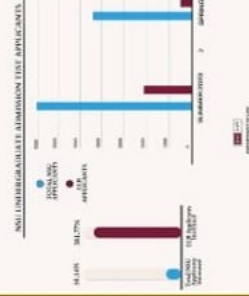
Dear all,

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS



The Department of Law, NSU, organized a webinar on "The Political Economy of Foreign Sovereign Immunity" on 8 June 2023. Maryam Jamshidi, Associate Professor of Law, University of Colorado Law School spoke as the Guest Speaker. Barrister Arafat Hosen Khan, Chair, Department of Law, North South University, gave the introductory remarks and Md.
