FAQs

1. What is the total cost of the Training? 20,000 BDT or 30,000 BDT?

The course costs 20,000 BDT. The approximate cost of the field trip to Cox's Bazar is 10,000 BDT. Participants do not need to pay the field trip cost during course registration.

2. What will I get after completing this course?

A Certificate of Completion which can be used to demonstrate professional development. Participants will be required to attend all sessions to obtain a completion certificate.

3. Is the field trip mandatory?

The field trip is optional.

4. How will I get the certificate? Physically or Online?

Answer: Physically. However, CPS will deliver the certificate to your address in case you are unable to collect it physically.

5. How long will the field trip be?

3 nights.

6. What will be the tentative date of the field trip?

The tentative date of the field trip is mid-August, 2021. The dates will be confirmed when the course begins.

7. Is there any alternative option if I could not join the field visit?

Participants not joining the field visit will write an alternative assignment.

8. Question: How will this course help to strengthen my career?

You will gain skills, empathy, and knowledge that can be applied to your professional life.

9. Question: How do I pay?

You may pay via bKash or through a bank. Both information are available in the course registration form.

10.What will be the course duration?

12 weeks (June 19 to September 4, 2021). Sessions will be held on Saturdays from 10am - 1.30am BST with a 30-minute break in between.

11. Can I share the reading materials or videos of the course with others?

The Chatham House Rule will be followed in this course. As a result, any information related to the course, should not be disclosed to the non-participants.
